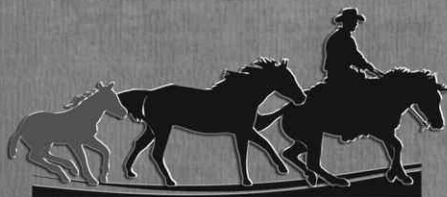

ANCILLARY ENTRY INFORMATION

Entry Deadlines: Ancillary classes

All ancillary entries are post entry and will be accepted until 5 p.m. the day before the class goes.

All entries must be made on an official NRHA Entry Form. Exhibitors are responsible for errors on entry forms. One entry form is required per horse and all entry forms must be filled out completely and correctly. Failure to do so could result in earnings not counting for Top Ten purposes. Payment must accompany the completed entry form. Do not at any time stop payment on entry fees or late fees. This could result in disciplinary action.

Judges Fees

Each entry is required to pay the judges fee for each class entered. For ancillary classes running concurrent, eligible exhibitors may enter all classes and all entry fees will apply. ONLY the greater of the judges' fees will apply when entering. Each entry will only run once and one score will count for the concurrent classes.

Video Fee

There will be a \$20.00 video fee charged for each horse per class. For classes that run concurrent, there will only be one \$20.00 charge.

Payment

All fees must be paid to the NRHA in U.S. funds.

Rider Changes

All rider changes must be made in the horse show office as soon as the change is known. If proper notification is not made prior to the class closing, NRHA will not be responsible for riders drawing up back to back or without at least eight horses (or highest number possible) between them.

Refunds

No refunds or credit for entry fees will be given for entries dropped or scratched for any reason after the class closes.

Back Numbers

Back numbers are assigned to horses, not to the exhibitor, and the back number must be displayed correctly each time the horse is shown as well as during scheduled warm-up times. Failure to display the correct back number in a visible manner while being judged will result in a \$25 fine.

AQHA & APHA CLASS ENTRY INFORMATION

Entry Fees and Deadlines

All ancillary entries are post entry and will be accepted until 5 p.m. the day before the class goes.

All entries must be made on an official NRHA Entry Form. Exhibitors are responsible for errors on entry forms. One entry form is required per horse and all entry forms must be filled out completely and correctly. Failure to do so could result in earnings not counting for Top Ten purposes. Payment must accompany the completed entry form. Do not at any time stop payment on entry fees or late fees. This could result in disciplinary action.

For all AQHA and APHA classes, the entry fees are as follows:

OPEN: \$75 per class; \$50 if cross entered in the NRHA Novice Horse Open class.

AMATEUR: \$55 per class; \$30 if cross entered in the NRHA Novice Horse Non Pro class.

YOUTH: \$20 per class; \$10 if cross entered in the NRHA Youth class.

Judges Fees

Each entry is required to pay the judges fee for each class entered. For ancillary classes running concurrent, eligible exhibitors may enter all classes and all entry fees will apply. ONLY the greater of the judges' fees will apply when entering. Each entry will only run once and one score will count for the concurrent classes.

Membership

- Current AQHA membership card for all AQHA exhibitors.
- Current membership card for all APHA Open, Amateur, or AjPHA exhibitors.
- Current NRHA membership card for NRHA classes if cross entering.

Video Fee

There will be a \$20.00 video fee charged for each horse per class. For classes that run concurrent, there will only be one \$20.00 charge.

Payment

All fees must be paid to the NRHA in U.S. funds.

Refunds

No refunds or credit for entry fees will be given for entries dropped or scratched for any reason after the class closes.

Documents Necessary to Pick Up Exhibitor Packets for AQHA & APHA classes

Please bring the following to the horse show office in order to make your entry and pick up your exhibitor packet:

- Copy of horse's registration papers.
- Current AQHA membership card for all AQHA exhibitors.
- Current APHA Open, Amateur, or AjPHA membership card for all APHA exhibitors.
- Health and Coggins papers (see Health Requirements in this publication.)

Drug and Medication

AQHA and APHA drug and medication rules will apply to the AQHA and APHA classes. All other NRHA Derby Show Conditions will apply.

Stall Information

Stall assignments are placed on a first come, first reserved basis. stall assignments may change without notification.

All horses on the show grounds must have a stall.

Stall Fees (horse and tack)

All fees are for the duration of the show unless otherwise noted.

All stall fees are per stall/per horse. Payment MUST accompany stall reservation form or the reservation will not be accepted.

Reserving Stalls

The Stall Reservation Form is available in this publication and is available for download at nrhaderby.com, or may be obtained by calling 405-946-7400.

Payment in full by check, credit card, or cash is required to be sent with the stall reservation form. Reservations received without payment will not be accepted. Payment is deposited upon receipt. Special requests will be noted, but will not guarantee assignment to the requested stall area.

Stall assignments will be handled as follows:

- Stall sponsors are placed first.
- All other reservations are placed based on the date received in the NRHA office and are placed on a first come, first reserved basis.
- If a stall agent requests more stalls after the closing date, every effort will be made to place the additional stall with the agent's other stalls, however there is no guarantee.
- If more than 20 stalls are requested, it may be necessary to split them between two separate locations.
- Only stall agents may add or remove stalls by written request.
- Stall agents are responsible for the payment of ALL stalls listed on their Stall Reservation Form.
- NRHA requires that the stall agent send the amount due in ONE payment.
- Stall agents must include all horses in their group on the stall reservation form to guarantee placement as a group. If you wish to be stalled with a trainer or another exhibitor, your reservations must be listed on the stall agent's (person reserving the stalls) reservation form.

All stall reservations must be received no later than May 21, 2010 in the NRHA office to be guaranteed placement. Reservations and additional stall requests received after May 21, 2010 must be purchased at the horse show office upon arrival.

Horse Move In

Horses may move in NO earlier than Friday, June 18th at 8:00 a.m. CST. Stall agents will be fined \$100 per horse/per stall/per day for early move in.

Bedding, Stall Safety, and Other Stall Guidelines

Bedding is not included in the stall fee and may be purchased from the Oklahoma State Fair Feed and Bedding Office based on availability. You may request that your bedding order be delivered to your stalling area prior to your arrival by contacting the Oklahoma State Fair Feed and Bedding Office prior to the start of the show by contacting the Feed and Bedding Office at 405-948-6786 or by fax 405-948-6787. A Bedding Order Form is available in this publication or at nrhaderby.com.

Stall Agents are required to keep their stalls clean and neat, to dispose of refuse matter in designated dump areas. Agents remove all items and materials installed, including tack stall decorations and all signs.

While fans are allowed, for safety reasons air conditioners are strictly prohibited in the stalling areas. All materials covering stalls MUST be flame retardant. If you have a question about a safety issue, please feel free to contact the Oklahoma City Fire Marshall or the Oklahoma State Fair offices at 405-948-6704.

Commercial use of stalls is strictly prohibited.

Stall Decorations

The Oklahoma City Fire Marshall mandates the following:

- There shall be NO plastic or vinyl material in the buildings, coverings for stalls, or used for temporary security of retail storefronts.
 - Only stalls for tack storage, entertainment, or sleeping can be covered on the top, and will require a smoke detector.
 - The stalls can only be covered in a red rosin construction grade paper or (butcher block paper) cheesecloth, either regular or restaurant type grade. Wood strapping—3' maximum on center to attach paper is allowed.
 - Sleeping areas are to be equipped with a smoke detector and fire extinguisher.
 - Any aisle space between stalls can be covered only if equal open space to material not to exceed 4 ft., i.e., if your material is max. 4 ft. then the space between material shall be minimum 4 ft.
 - No two (2) continuous stalls per aisle way, shall be covered at any time.
 - Combustible storefront elevations shall be treated in ACCORDANCE WITH NFPA 701 to make them flame retardant and a certificate or similar proof is supplied to the Oklahoma City Fire Marshals office prior to its placing. Material that is being treated by user must be done in the presence of an Inspector from the City of Oklahoma City Fire Marshals office.
 - Awnings shall not exceed out from stalls any further than 4 ft.
 - No portable heaters of any type are allowed in the Oklahoma City Fairground livestock facilities.
 - NO tents or canopies are allowed inside the barns, arena, or livestock area. This is to include but not limited to EZ-UP pop up tents.
 - NO SMOKING will be permitted in Arena or Livestock area (BARNs)
 - NO hay, straw, shavings, or similar combustible materials used for decorations are permitted within any facility unless they have been treated in ACCORDANCE WITH NFPA 701 to make them flame retardant and a certificate or similar proof is supplied to the Oklahoma City Fire Marshals office prior to its placing. (Hay or straw for animals is permissible and can be kept in stall areas for feed and or bedding.)
 - Combustible trash shall be removed at least once a day during the period the arena/exhibit is occupied.
- Any violations of the fire code are subject to fines or removal from the grounds by the Oklahoma City Fire Marshall.

Stall Refunds

Stall fees will only be refunded if a written request from the STALL AGENT is received by the NRHA office on or before June 21, 2010. A \$30 handling fee will be charged per stall on requests made after June 21 and before June 26. There will be NO stall refunds made for requests received June 27 or later.

GENERAL SHOW INFORMATION

Final Interpretation of Rules

Show management reserves the right to discipline any person(s) that has violated these show conditions, abused or permitted abusive behavior against a horse, or engaged in unsportsmanlike conduct toward show management, judges or exhibitors. Discipline will include an official warning and could lead to fines and ultimate disqualification or elimination from competition. Unsportsmanlike conduct will not be tolerated. Unsportsmanlike conduct shall be defined as any action of disrespect, deceit or fraud directed to judges, show management, show representatives, the NRHA, NRHA members or other exhibitors.

Right to Cancel

The NRHA Executive Board reserves the right to refuse any/all entries, or transfers of entry, without notice to the exhibitor/owner. Acceptance of the entry is based on the representations made on the entry form. Decisions of the Executive Committee will be final. Riders are responsible to know and adhere to eligibility requirements for NRHA

events. A rider who enters an event or division in which he/she is not eligible (or enters a horse that is not eligible), will forfeit all winnings and entry fees to the NRHA, and may be subject to disciplinary action by the NRHA Board of Directors for unsportsmanlike conduct as set forth in the current *NRHA Handbook*. The rider is responsible for the entry information regardless of whether the form is completed by the rider, agent, or owner. The National Reining Horse Association reserves the right to cancel this event without notice at any time prior to the show without liability, but in such event will return all entry money to the payers. Interest earned on the entry money is the property of the National Reining Horse Association.

NRHA rules will apply unless specifically deleted or altered. These rules and conditions are subject to change by action of the NRHA Board of Directors.

Liability

Classes will be operated exclusively in accordance with NRHA rules. The NRHA officers and board of directors reserve the right to interpret these rules and regulations. All decisions will be final. The owner, rider, and/or agent that signs the Release and Waiver of Liability assumes responsibility for and is bound to the terms and conditions of the Release and Waiver of Liability contained on the entry form or signed at the show.

Cell Phone Usage

NO cell phones are to be used while riding in any of the arenas.

Class Patterns

Pattern numbers for each class are printed in this publication and on the NRHA Web site. Pattern Books will be available in the horse show office.

Membership

All owners, co-owners, and riders must be current members of the National Reining Horse Association. A current membership form is available from the NRHA office or at nrhaderby.com or will be available for purchase in the horse show office. Please refer to the AQHA & APHA section of the conditions for membership requirements pertaining to those classes.

Competition License

Horses competing in any NRHA approved class must have an NRHA competition license. New licenses and transfers of ownership can be completed by the NRHA office or the horse show office prior to showing.

Draw/Working Order

The draw or working orders will be posted at the show. NO DRAW INFORMATION WILL BE GIVEN OUT BY PHONE. Please do not call the NRHA office for this information.

Documents Necessary to Pick Up Exhibitor Packets

Please bring the following to the horse show office in order to make your entry and pick up your exhibitor packet:

- Copy of NRHA membership cards for owners, co-owners, and riders.
- Copy of horse's NRHA competition license
- Copy of breed registration papers, if entering AQHA/APHA classes or if requested by Show Management
- Health and Coggins papers

Show Passes

Show passes may be purchased for \$30 in the horse show office and will allow entry for all performances. Tickets for individual performances will be available at the State Fair Coliseum Box Office at 405-948-6808. Box seat tickets may be purchased by contacting the NRHA office at 405-946-7400.

Judging

At least two judges will judge all classes (except for AQHA/APHA classes). When two judges are used, the two judges' scores will be tallied to determine the final score. When five judges are used, the high and low scores will be dropped and the remaining scores will be tallied to determine the final score.

Open Checks

No open checks will be accepted by mail prior to the show, however, open checks will be accepted at the show. Any open checks left open at the end of the show and that have to be closed out by the NRHA office following the show will be charged an additional \$50.

Photographers/Videographers

Show Management may request the services of official photographers and videographers during the event. The resulting photographs and/or videos may be used for promotional purposes at the discretion of NRHA. No exhibitor will be allowed the discretionary use of the photographers/videographers services. In addition, NRHA has the right to record, broadcast and otherwise exploit, in any and all media throughout the world, any performance in the event, horse's name, likeness, voice, and biographical information in connection therewith.

Prize Money

Prize money will be paid to the owner or designated agent of an entered horse as

recorded at the start of the event. Appropriate tax information must be on file with the NRHA office. If ownership of a horse is transferred during the show, the previous owner and the new owner must complete an Authorization of Prize Money Payment Form. Appropriate tax information must be on file with the NRHA office. The owner of record at the end of competition will receive a 1099 for any prize money earned.

IRS Withholding for International Competitors:

International competitors (with residence outside the U.S.) are subject to as much as 30% withholding for U.S. Internal Revenue Service purposes. International competitors are encouraged to provide a U.S. tax ID number or to complete the appropriate forms to avoid maximum withholding.

Posted Class Results

Scores and placings in all classes will be posted in a designated area.

Retainage

All ancillary classes will have a 50% show retainage of entry fees.

Scratches

Please advise the NRHA show office if you plan to scratch from a class. No refunds will be made for horses scratched.

FACILITY GUIDELINES

Dog Rule

All dogs must be confined and on a leash at all times on the show grounds. Loose dogs will not be tolerated. Dogs are not permitted in the coliseum. Owners of dogs that are barking excessively may be asked to remove their dog(s) from the show grounds. Dogs wandering into the arena, working areas or the gate areas will be confined and owners will be fined prior to their release. Any dog picked up by county authorities will be confined for 30 days per Oklahoma City ordinance.

Extension Cord Requirements

If extension cords are used at the horse show facility, Ground Fault Interrupter Protection (GFIP) is required. These cords are easily recognized as there is a test and reset button on the cord. Most of these cords have the words "GFCI protected" printed on them. All 120 volt extension cords must be three-wire grounding type cords (recognized by the three prong plug on the end of the cord.) Frayed or damaged cords may not be used. Extension cords may not be installed through doors. Only heavy duty extension cords with their own fusible link will be allowed.

These requirements help eliminate harmful or fatal hazards to you or your animals. City staff, including the Fire Marshall will check the premises periodically for compliance.

Loading and Unloading Trailers

Arriving and departing horse trailers and vans will be allowed loading and unloading privileges in a timely manner, and then must move to the designated parking area.

Non-Smoking Facility

No smoking is allowed in any building on the Oklahoma State Fairgrounds. Smoking is strictly prohibited in the barns and stabling areas as well as in the Coliseum by order of the Fire Marshall of Oklahoma City, OK.

Parking

Car, pickup truck, van, and trailer parking will be in designated areas. Please park in these areas only. Violators will be towed. Exhibitors must adhere to regulatory signs posted by the State Fair of Oklahoma and NRHA. NRHA is assessed the cost of towing to keep fire lanes open and these charges will be passed on to the individuals violating these signs. Fire lanes and fire hydrants must be clear at all times.

Physical Damage

Individuals will be responsible for any physical damage inflicted to property of the State Fair of Oklahoma and reimbursement must be paid to NRHA for such damage.

Recreational and Camper Hookups

A camping area with RV hook ups is available on a first come, first served basis. Payment will be made to the Oklahoma State Fair Park and management of this service will be provided by the same. They can be contacted at 405-948-6700.

VIP hook ups are available at the North end of Barn 9. Spots will be sold on a first come first serve basis. There are a total of 29 spaces. Every new VIP camping space comes with water and sewer hookup, 50 amp electrical service, and paved parking. The form to reserve spots in this area is included in this *Premium Book*.

Safety Hazards

No bicycles, scooters, roller blades, skateboards, golf carts, air conditioners, propane tanks or satellite dishes will be allowed inside or within close proximity of the barns or arenas at any time. Portable generators are prohibited unless approved by the Fire Marshall. All portable lights must be of the low voltage UL Listed type. These items are a safety hazard and will be dealt with accordingly. If you have a question about a safety issue, please feel free to contact the Oklahoma City Fire Marshall or the Oklahoma State Fair offices at 405-948-6704.

Signs, Posters, Etc.

If any promotional material is placed on any horse show property and it defaces or destroys the property, parties responsible will be charged for the cost of having the property repaired or replaced. NRHA reserves the right to remove any posted signs, posters or promotional material.

Check Cashing

The horse show office will not cash checks. There is an ATM located in the main entrance of the Oklahoma State Fair Coliseum.

HEALTH REQUIREMENTS

The State of Oklahoma requires a negative Coggins test within twelve months and a 30-day health certificate for horses traveling from out of state. For in-state horses, a negative Coggins within 12 months is required. Emergency regulations regarding specific disease outbreaks (such as vesicular stomatitis) may require additional information or procedures. Call the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food and Forestry at 405-522-6141 for the most current Oklahoma equine health requirements. NOTE: Oklahoma law requires show management to view all health papers and Coggins tests. Please be prepared to show these papers to management upon request or at the entry office when entering and picking up entry packets.

VIOLATIONS OF SHOW CONDITIONS

Any violations of these show conditions may be considered unsportsmanlike conduct. Discipline will include an official warning and could lead to fines and ultimate disqualification from competition and/or participation. ♦

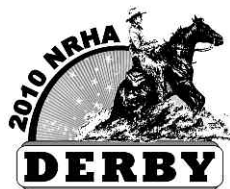

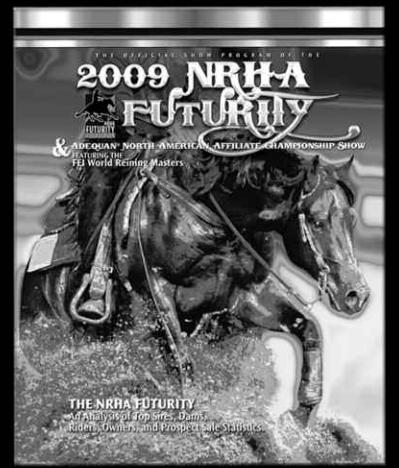

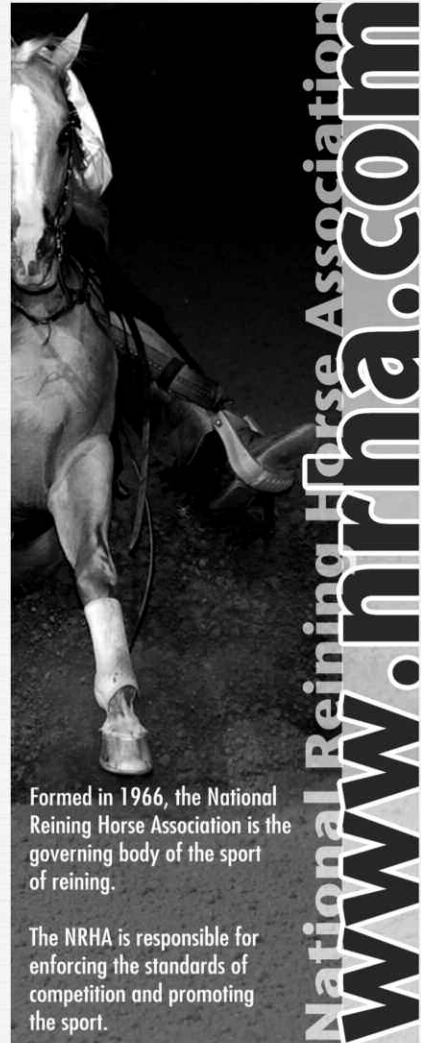
