Arena 6 is Open to only horses showing in the Coliseum Arena. A gate Steward will check you in to Arena 6 for this scheduled schooling.

Important: Unless otherwise noted, Area 6 is closed for two hours at the completion of each day's show in the Coliseum Arena. This time is used for footing work in Arena 6.

Once complete for the day in the Coliseum, Arena 6 is open for any horses once the final run has completed in the Coliseum until the Kiser Footing Crews begin work the following morning, or at any point during the night that footing work is necessary.

Arena 3 is available for lunging and open schooling at all times, with the following exceptions:

Tuesday, June 23 – Arena Closed for Exhibitor Party and Egg & Spoon Race until approx. 9pm

Thursday, June 25 – Arena Closed for USEF/FEI Open Horse Inspection from 3:00pm until approx. 5:00pm

Friday, June 26 – Arena Closed for USEF/FEI Youth Horse Inspection from 9:00am until approx. 11:30am

Note: Lunging should be restricted to Arena 3. Riders are encouraged to ride in other areas when lunging horses are present.

Arena 7A is Open to only horses showing in the Adequan® Championship Arena.

Arena 7B is the make-ready arena for horses showing in the Adequan® Championship Arena. Only the next **5 horses** are allowed into this area to make final preparations to show.

Outside of show hours in the Adequan® Championship Arena, Area 7 is open at all times for schooling.
