The Non Pro Qualifiers will run concurrently with the Ancillary Non Pro classes. Class 114 runs concurrently with Class 115 which has a total entry fee of \$300. Class 214 runs concurrently with Class 215 which has a total entry fee of \$450. Entries must be entered in the Non Pro ancillary classes as well as pay the \$250 Qualifier fee per slate.

Pay \$250 fee per division, per slate to be eligible to qualify for The Run For A Million. Riders qualify only once and do not need to compete in the Championship on the horse that was used to qualify. To compete, riders must own or lease the horse based on NRHA rules. Remit payment with this form payable to the NRHA Derby.
