**Class Structure and Rules**

- Limited to 20 entries each class.
  - If one class does not fill, we will accept more in the other class to reach 40 maximum runs or both combined).
- Rider may only cross enter Green Reiner, Youth and Rookie classes.
- **Fees:**
  - \$20 Entry fee (\$10 back to purse). No judge's fee.
  - No video fee. No office fee, meds or haul-in fee for horses entered only in Ranch Reining.
- **Added money:** \$50.
- **Ownership:** Non Pro and Youth ownership restrictions apply.
- **No Membership Requirements:** Memberships and licenses are not required during the pilot phase.

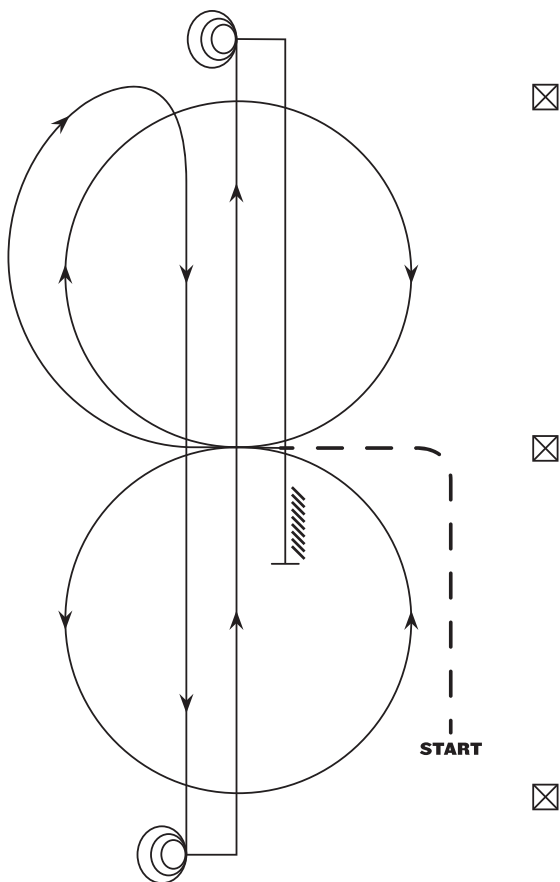
**Judging Standards**

- NRHA Green Reiner guidelines for riding two-handed and simple lead changes.
- **Ranch Equipment Standards:**
  - No hoof polish, no hoof black. No braided or banded manes/tails or tail extensions.
  - Holding the saddle horn with either hand will not be penalized in any Ranch Reining class.
  - Equipment with silver should not count over a good working outfit. Excessive silver on bridles and saddles is discouraged.
- **Pattern:** AQHA Versatility Ranch Horse Ranch Reining Pattern 6
- **Results and Earnings:** Not recorded on NRHA records during the pilot phase.

## VRH AND RHC RANCH REINING PATTERN 6



**Mandatory Marker along Fence or Wall:** The judge shall indicate with markers on arena wall or fence the center of pattern. Judge shall also place markers on fence or wall at least 50' from each end of the arena.

Ride pattern as follows: Trot to center of arena and stop or walk before departure. Start pattern facing toward judge.

1. Beginning on right lead, lope one circle to the right. Change leads at center of arena.
2. Complete one circle to the left. Change leads at center of arena.
3. Begin a circle to the right, but do not close this circle. Run down center of arena, past the end marker, and do a sliding stop.
4. Complete 3 1/2 spins to the right.
5. Run up to other end of arena, past the end marker, do a sliding stop.
6. Complete 3 1/2 spins to the left.
7. Run past the center marker and do a sliding stop. Back at least 10 feet. Hesitate to show completion pattern.

### Purpose of Form

An individual or entity (Form W-9 requester) who is required to file an information return with the IRS must obtain your correct taxpayer identification number (TIN) which may be your social security number (SSN), individual taxpayer identification number (ITIN), adoption taxpayer identification number (ATIN), or employer identification number (EIN), to report on an information return the amount paid to you, or other amount reportable on an information return. Examples of information returns include, but are not limited to, the following:

- Form 1099-INT (interest earned or paid)
- Form 1099-DIV (dividends, including those from stocks or mutual funds)
- Form 1099-MISC (various types of income, prizes, awards, or gross proceeds)
- Form 1099-B (stock or mutual fund sales and certain other transactions by brokers)
- Form 1099-S (proceeds from real estate transactions)
- Form 1099-K (merchant card and third party network transactions)
- Form 1099 (home mortgage interest), 1099-E (student loan interest), 1099-T (tuition)
- Form 1099-C (canceled debt)
- Form 1099-A (acquisition or abandonment of secured property)

Use Form W-9 only if you are a U.S. person (including a resident alien), to provide your correct TIN.

If you do not return Form W-9 to the requester with a TIN, you might be subject to backup withholding. See *What is backup withholding*, later.
