



OPEN AND NON PRO FOUR-YEAR-OLD STAKES CONDITIONS

Level 4 Open - \$110,000 Added
Level 3 Open - \$45,000 Added
Level 2 Open - \$30,000 Added
Level 1 Open - \$20,000 Added

Level 4 Non Pro - \$50,000 Added
Level 3 Non Pro - \$30,000 Added
Level 2 Non Pro - \$15,000 Added
Level 1 Non Pro - \$10,000 Added

1. The Open and Non Pro Four-Year-Old Stakes will be run concurrently with the NRHA Derby go rounds. Horses must be four-years-old in order to enter. Horses may be shown one-handed in any legal bridle. The winner will be determined in the go rounds. Cross-entry into the NRHA Derby is allowed, but not mandatory. There are no nomination requirements for a horse to only be entered in the Four-Year-Old Stakes. Nomination requirements apply for entry into the NRHA Derby open and non pro divisions.
2. The NRHA Open Four-Year-Old Stakes will consist of four divisions: Level 4 Open, Level 3 Open, Level 2 Open and Level 1 Open. Entry into the Level 3 Open, Level 2 Open, and Level 1 Open will be automatic based on rider eligibility. Please see the current NRHA Eligibility Policy for eligibility requirements. The entry fee for the Level 4 Open Four-Year-Old Stakes will be \$700. If not cross-entered into the NRHA Derby, a \$13 video fee and \$120 judges fee will be applied.
3. The NRHA Non Pro Four-Year-Old Stakes will consist of four divisions: Level 4 Non Pro, Level 3 Non Pro, Level 2 Non Pro and Level 1 Non Pro. Entries may enter at any level for which they are eligible and are required to enter up at least one division for the Levels 3 through 1 Non Pro divisions. Please see the current NRHA Eligibility Policy for eligibility requirements. The entry fee for the Level 4 Non Pro Four-Year-Old Stakes will be \$200, \$75 for the Level 3 Non Pro, \$75 for the Level 2 Non Pro and \$75 for the Level 1 Non Pro. If not cross-entered into the NRHA Derby, a \$13 video fee and \$120 judges fee will be applied.
4. Payouts will be paid using Payback Schedule B for both the Open and the Non Pro divisions
